AMERICA: EXCEPTIONAL or EVIL?

"ORIGINS"

"unique", different
beginning of the "new" world
a "refuge" from world's oppression
founded on "noble" principles
being "different" made it successful
Founders self-less, political geniuses
"City on a Hill" - role models for world
individual Life, liberty, pursuit of happiness

The American Dream egalitarian, individualistic "content of character"

"arrogant"
our "greatness" the "fruit of evil"
we are the oppressors – "enemy"
self-righteous pride, hubris
"different" leading to pride/arrogance,
Founders elitist exploiters, oppressors
stereotypical "ugly, stupid American"
ss needed, collective social justice
the World's ""Nightmare"

elitist, arrogant, narcissism

POLITICS

experiment in *self-government* imperial domination violating foreign sovereignty ending feudal tyranny around world *hypocritical* tyranny, victim-izing the world God-centered; religious freedom *betrayal* of "promise" - "sold soul to the devil" 'divine-ly" inspired, inalienable rights human-centered economic interests

SOCIETY

Constitutional "civil" rights racial-social segregation and institutional bigotry government of "laws", not men

All people created equal "income inequality the biggest issue of our time" tolerance (fueled by individualism) our "collective sins"- racism, sexism, capitalism "E Pluribus Unum" - out of many, one xenophobia, homophobia pluralism (freedom of *choice*) need for "political correctness" (*conformity*)

RACE

race-less – color-blind ideals American world's most color-blind society installer, racism not uniquely American abolitionist movement led by U.S./British unique- fought Civil War to end slavery slavery still exists in Africa, around world

Ameri-KKKa - racist, even "genocidal" history institutionally racist (e.g. "white privilege") founded with, perpetuated slavery tish "King" cotton – slave economy segregation continues after war (1865-1963) orld slavery a continuing American legacy

CULTURE

immigrant friendly, accepting world's "rejects" cultural "melting pot" cultural "white man's burden" and "blessings": the "bur wealth, democracy, technology, medicine law, education "white m

jects" xenophobic (fear of "outsider")
cultural "arrogance", false superiority
the "burden", hypocrisy of exceptionalism
made world "slaves of the machine"
"white man's greed created a world in need"

ECONOMICS

equality of *opportunity* (rags to riches) inequalities of wealth; oppression of 1% private enterprise enriched untold millions crony capitalism enriched robber barons industrial revolution – economic *miracle* industrialized economic exploitation raw materials, material progress & development environmental degradation unprecedented wealth creation for untold millions "gluttons" for world's resources world's poor find promised land to middle class exploits poor; perpetuates poverty our "poor" are "rich" in most of the world "rich man's war, poor man's fight" sweatshops feed our consumerism, consumption industrialization fed immigration a golden age of economic expansion a gilded age – gold on outside, ugly on inside escape from "Old World" of feudal tyranny "One World Order" globalized tyranny

WEALTH

scapegoated by global jealousy, envy, hate when U.S. prospers, the world prospers "A high tide raises all boats" cor most *generous* nation on earth billions in "foreign aid"; disaster relief

ate bringers of pain, death, destruction we are not "center of the universe" corporate greed – military-industrial complex *greediest* nation on earth foreign "aid" to dictators, elites

FOREIGN RELATIONS

we do not start, we "finish" wars unilateral intervention but never "finish the job" peace-seeking, leader of "free nations" wars for oil, military-industrial complex world's "policeman-protector" "war-mongering" cowboys – reckless and violent self-less fighting tyranny around world gunboat-dollar diplomacy - selfish interests U.S. military – "a force for good" militarism – a force for evil moral diplomacy -"Save the world for democracy" "Bush lied, people died." reluctant, selfless global liberators willing, selfish imperial conquerors isolationist, anti-"empire" interventionist, "meddling", world domination ending WW I – "Save world for democracy" U.S. industry profit\$ from war WW II stops Nazi-Japanese fascism U.S. corporations help subsidize Hitler becomes world "superpower" militaristic threat of nuclear holocaust Cold War leader preventing spread support anti-communist dictators around world

CONCLUSIONS

a *strong* America makes world *better* a *weak* America makes world *worse* making *best* of a *bad* world by doing nothing or "appeasing" evil, leads to *more* evil

freedom from communist tyranny

a weak-er America makes world better "leading from behind"; the burden of power accepting "superpower" is "pact with the devil" exceptionalism brings exceptional problems we perpetuate evil – stop it

CIA overthrows of *popular*-elected leaders

Lincoln - the world's *last, best hope*" transformation – "Change we can believe in" needed "restoration/reconstruction" needed "de-construction" of flawed founding of original ideals, values & past success stop violating our founding principles
